The keys are located in the key box between the two doors of the main entrance.

THE CODE IS: CLEAR + 2580 + OPEN BUTTON

Parking is easily available near the house. You can park directly <u>in front</u> of our courtyard entrance, despite our sign stating otherwise. To park in the courtyard, the key is hanging inside near the telephone.

The Wi-Fi network is **CASA** and the password is **180290Giorgia**

Once connected to Wi-Fi, you can use an Apple device to play music on the speakers via the Apple TV «SALON»

Your Departure

Lock the doors securely, including the back door, and remember to return the keys to the key box between the two doors.

Some Information

- The air conditioning control is located on the second floor at the top of the stairs, right next to the window.
- For heating, each room has its own thermostat. Feel free to adjust them as needed. Be careful not to stick anything on the radiators in the house.
- A hair dryer is located in the drawer unit in the center of the bathroom.
- The compost bin is under the sink. When it's full, put the filled purple bag directly into the large black trash can outside. Spare bags are under the kitchen sink.
- Cleaning supplies are under the kitchen sink.
- The central vacuum is behind the door leading to the basement (under the stairs).
- To turn on the yard lights, use the small black lever hanging to the right of the back door.

Kitchen

- We don't have a lot of storage space; everything you need is usually within easy reach.
- Under the sink, you'll find other dishes, a blender, and dishwasher tablets.
- The pots and pans are in the fireplace above the old woodburning stove.
- The microwave is built into this old wood-burning stove. (Open both doors to access it.)
- Other dishes (wine glasses, oven dishes) are on the other side of the room in the large cupboard.
- One burner on the stove isn't working properly; this is indicated on the switch.
- We have a Nespresso coffee maker and a milk frother. Feel free to use the capsules we left for you. A moka pot is also available.
- Filtered water flows from the small faucet and the soap dispenser is good for hands and dishes.
